STUDENTS EXECUTIVE COUNCIL (SEC)

1. Chairperson
2. The Vice-Chairperson, who shall be of the opposite gender with the Chairperson
3. Secretary General
4. Finance Secretary
5. Academic Secretary
6. Games, Sports and Entertainment Secretary
7. Gender and Special Interest Secretary- to be elected immediately after the results of the six (6) positions in SEC have been determined

STUDENTS' REPRESENTATIVES FROM ELECTORAL COLLEGES

1. 2 Representatives (Male and Female) School of Education and Social Sciences
2. 2 Representatives (Male and Female) School of Business and Economics
3. 1 Representatives School of Science
4. 1 Representatives School of Computing, Informatics and Technology
5. 2 Representatives (Male and Female) Halls of Residence.
6. 2 Non-Resident Representatives (Male and Female). Must be Non-Resident
7. 2 Representatives (Male & Female) School of Graduate Studies to be nominated

All interested persons are hereby requested to apply for these positions thereafter collect nomination and clearance forms from the Office of Dean of Students.

Duly filled nomination and clearance forms should be submitted to the Office of the Dean of Students not later than Wednesday 12th January, 2022 at 12: 00 noon.

Campaigns with start on 17th to 20th January, 2022.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELECTION TO PARLIAMENT

One qualifies to be elected to parliament if at the date of nomination for election such a person:

- a) Is a bona fide student of KAFUCO
- b) Is registered in the Electoral College / Parliamentary area the member seeks to represent.
- c) Have a minimum average grade of 60% in the immediate previous academic year University examinations
- d) A first year student intending to contest should have an average of 60 % of the available academic results.
- e) Not be a member of Students Electoral Commission.
- f) Have been cleared by the Electoral Commission
- g) Not have been proven guilty in a disciplinary case in the University.
- h) Not have held position in SEC or Parliament for two terms in KAFUCOSO or any other University in Kenya.
- i) Must not have served in the SEC or Parliament for more than two terms

NOTE:

- a) After nomination, candidates shall automatically be disqualified from elections if they incite other students to use violence, boycott lectures, and threaten or ridicule any member of staff or students.
- b) Each candidate running for the position of Chairperson shall nominate a running mate of opposite gender and different ethnic background for the Office of Vice Chairperson.
- c) An election offence shall include: Impersonation, Rigging, Violence, Intimidation, giving false information, campaigning on the polling day, any other offence that Electoral Commission may define as an act of commission or omission of any other rules governing the conduct of election.
- d) **Attach two colored passport photo on your application form.**
